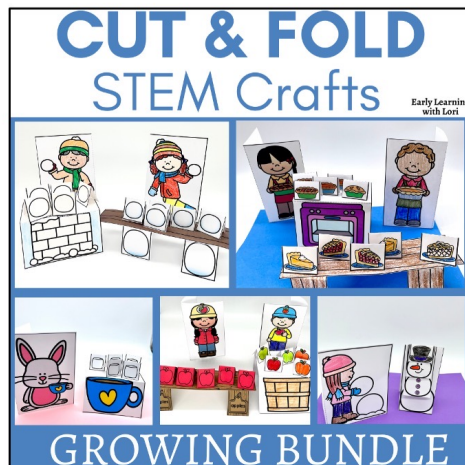

# Parts of a Sunflower Craft

## Materials Needed:

- Parts of a Sunflower printable
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Markers or crayons
- **See Photos page for suggested sunflower materials**
  - Flower: yellow tissue paper or cupcake liner
  - Flower center: pom poms or sunflower seeds
  - Stem: green craft stick or drinking straw
  - Leaves: pieces of green construction paper
  - Roots: white yarn

## Craft Instructions:

### 1. Cut out the flower parts:

1. **Leaves:** Cut two or more leaf shapes from green paper.
2. **Roots:** pieces of white yarn represent the roots.

### 2. Assemble the flower:

1. Glue the yellow paper or cupcake liner on the flower.
2. Add the flower center to the flower.
3. Attach the stem.
4. Glue the leaves onto the stem.
5. Glue the roots to the soil.

### 3. Decorate (Optional):

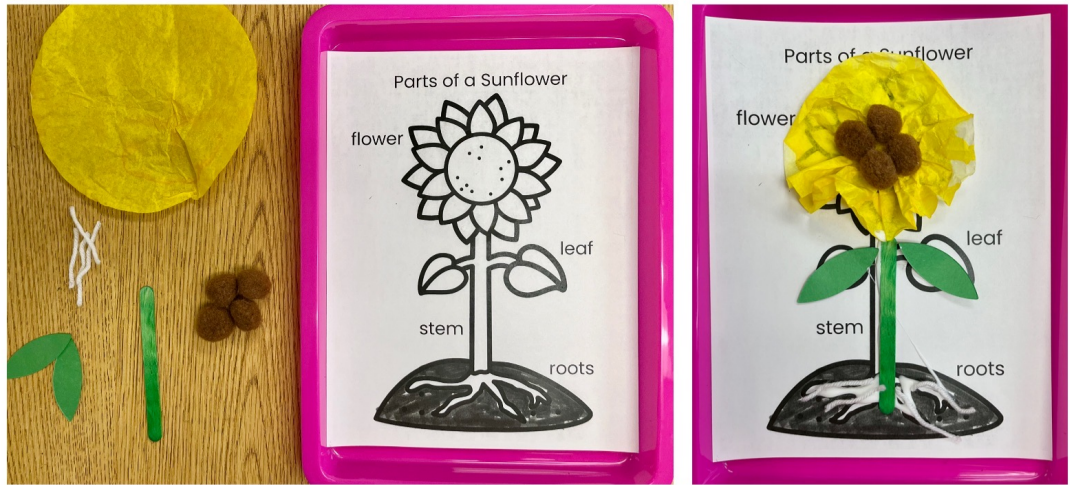
Color the background, add insects, or make a garden scene!

### 4. Version #2 Label the parts:

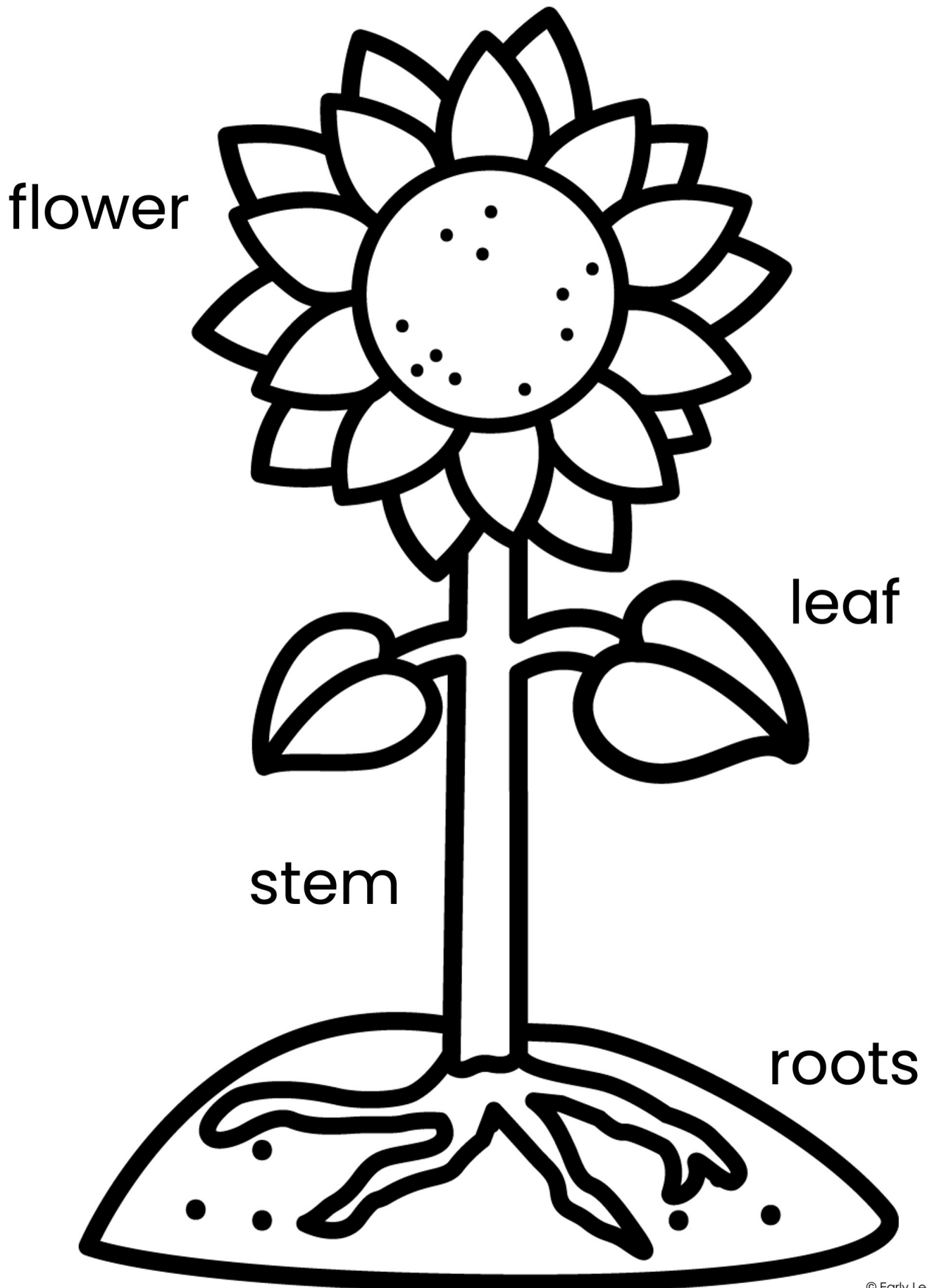

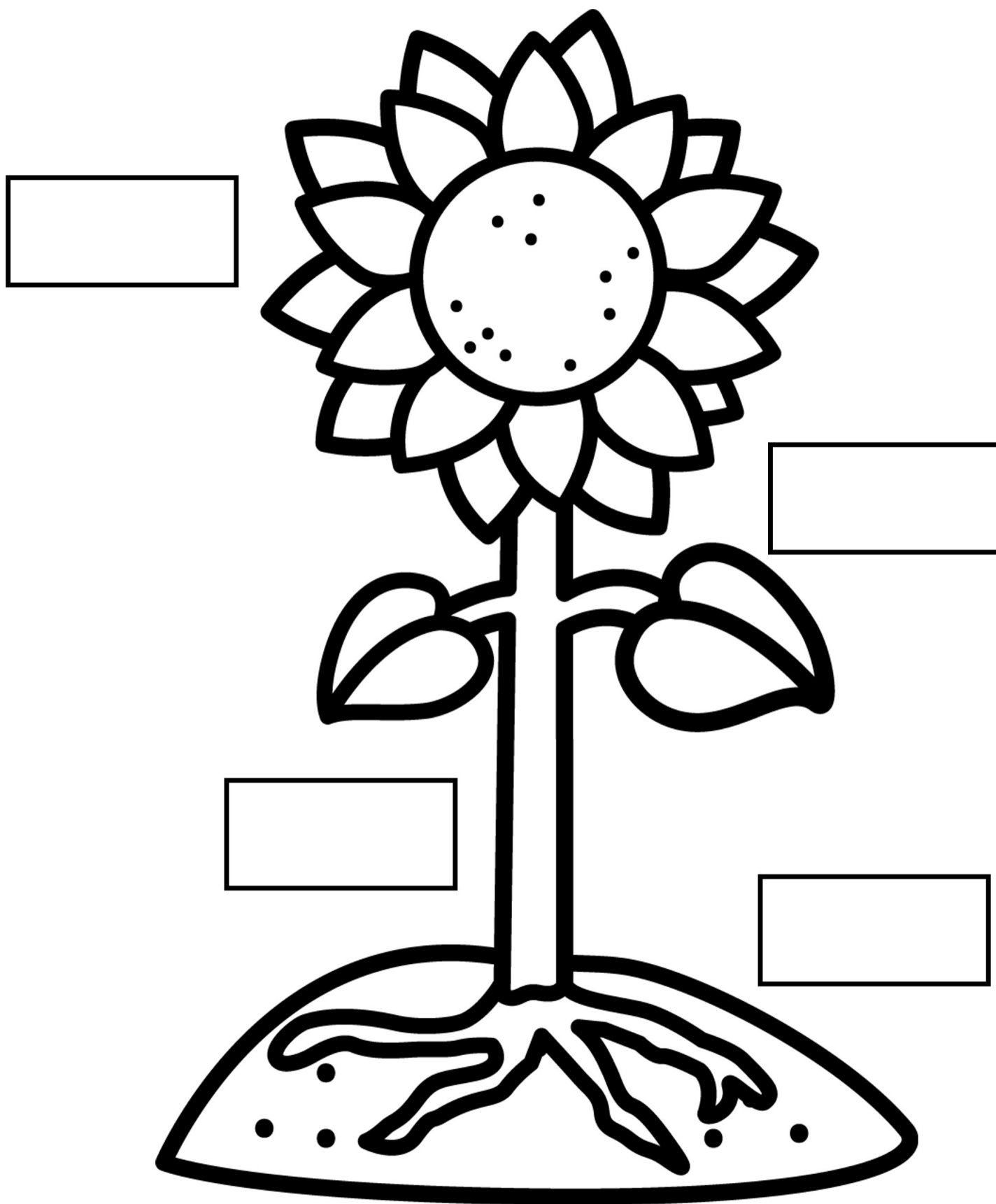
